
NSW Secondary Students' Post-School Destinations Survey 2019

Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation

This fact sheet provides a high level overview of findings from the 2019 NSW Secondary Students' Post-School Destinations and Expectations survey of students who left school in 2018, including early school leavers and Year 12 completers. In 2019, a total of 24,912 school leavers completed the survey.

Post-school destinations of all school leavers in 2019

In 2019, 88.5% of all school leavers were in education, training or employment. The remainder were either looking for work or not in the labour force, education or training.

- 3. Storepersons 8.6%
