1 INTRODUCING KOREAN MARKETS

Mini task 1

Mini task 2

Create a dialogue between a customer and a shopkeeper to practise purchasing items and using Korean *won*.

3 NEGOTIATING PRICES AND HAGGLING

- Use culturally appropriate terms when addressing, thanking and farewellling a customer
- Ask for a discount or negotiate a lower price
- Effectively negotiate an agreed price
- Demonstrate cultural awareness by interacting respectfully when haggling
