Calculating Fee Relief Payment

Case Study 1

A family sends their 5 year old child to a long day care preschool program with a daily session fee of \$137.00. They receive the Child Care Subsidy, leaving the family to pay a daily gap fee of \$26.45. The child attends the service 2 days a week, for a total weekly gap fee of \$52.90.

The service operates for 52 weeks per year and does not charge any additional fees.

Calculating Fee Relief Payment over 52 weeks:		
Step 1	Calculate weekly fee relief available to child	\$2,110 accessed over 52 weeks = \$40.57 available to this family per week
Step 2	Calculate weekly gap fee after CCS applied	\$26.45 x 2 days = \$52.90
Step 3	Apply fee relief to weekly gap fee after CCS applied	\$52.90 - \$40.57 = \$12.33 remaining weekly gap fee

Case Study 2

A family sends their 5 year old child to a long day care preschool program with a daily session fee of \$110. They do not receive the Child Care Subsidy, leaving the family to pay a daily fee of \$110. The child attends the service 4 days a week, for a total weekly fee of \$440.

The service operates for 49 weeks per year and does not charge any additional fees.

Calculating Fee Relief Payment over 49 weeks:		
Step 1	Calculate weekly fee relief available to child	\$2,110 accessed over 49 weeks = \$43.06 available to this family per week
Step 2	Calculate weekly gap fee after CCS applied	\$110 x 4 days = \$440
Step 3	Apply fee relief to weekly gap fee after CCS applied	\$440 - \$43.06 = \$396.94 remaining weekly gap fee
