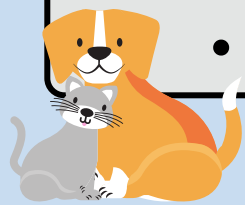

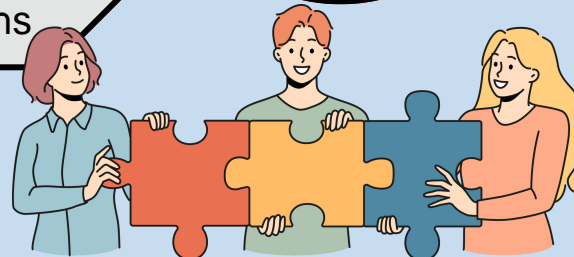
MAKING CONNECTIONS

- Justify opinions about neighbourhoods, including your ideal place to live

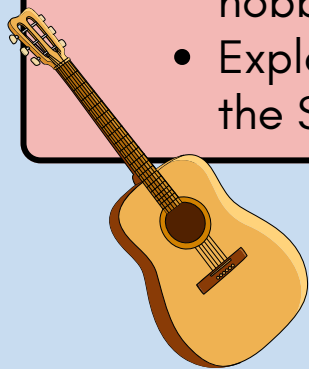

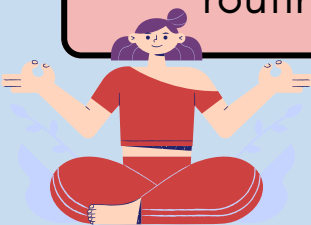
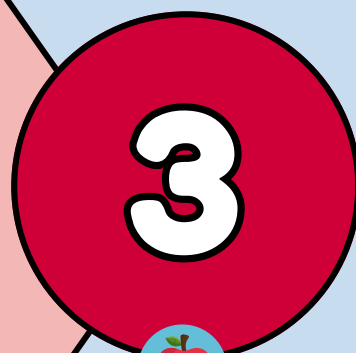
- Explore a variety of holiday activities and destinations
