Information for parents of NDIS participants

Transport through the Assisted School Travel Program (ASTP) is provided as an <u>in-kind support</u> for participants of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) who are eligible to receive an ASTP service.



Does the request to transport the student to and from school meet the ASTP's eligibility criteria?



Submit an application, variation or change request with the ASTP



## **VARIATIONS**

- Variations are requests to change existing ASTP student transport arrangements to and from school on a permanent or temporary basis.
- ► Families can request a temporary variation to current transport arrangements via the school.



Discuss transport options with the NDIA



- The ASTP is managed by the NSW Department of Education, not the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).
- ► The ASTP is not a registered NDIS service provider.
- ➤ The ASTP and the NDIS operate separately. The ASTP does not have access to information about individual NDIS support plans.
