Public Speaking + Radio



Woniora Road students want their voices to be heard!

To help their voices be heard far and wide the students record a show for local community radio.

Each Wednesday, Woniora Road students host the 'Wizards' program which airs on 90.1nbc FM. The students control the mixing desk, curate the playlist, and make community announcements. The students also provide recommendations for movies and discuss a range of topics.

To refine their radio and public speaking skills the students completed a public speaking course. Students explored what makes a good public speaker, including vocal and breathing exercises, posture and other body movements, and performance psychology.

Armed with knowledge, students then practiced these skills and made recordings at various stages of their development.

Challenges and solutions

Students of an SSP sometimes express that their voices are not heard. Speaking on the radio has helped Woniora Road students have risen to the challenge and developed a variety of new skills and interests over the period of the radio program.

Producing a show for 90.1NBC community radio has built confidence in our students. It has also assisted them to articulate and express their feelings and opinions. Many have discovered a new passion for music and broadcasting. The impact for students is evident in the benefits to their wellbeing and the overall success of the show is a testament to their hard work.
