Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI)	The TFI examines the extent to which Tier 1 Universal Prevention Features, Tier 2 Targeted PBL Features and Tier 3 Intensive PBL features are in place.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Valid, reliable and efficient measure of the extent to which school personnel are applying the core features of School-wide Positive Behaviour for Learning. Intended to guide both the initial implementation, progression through the tiers and the sustained use of PBL. 	School PBL team with input from Tier 2/3 teams if these are in place of the school's Learning and Support Team.	Four times a year until a score of at least 80% per tier is reached	Approximately 1 hour per tier.
School Wide Evaluation Tool (SET)	The SET assesses and evaluates Tier 1 Universal Prevention Features.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Measures the extent to which Tier 1 Universal Prevention Features are in place Determines annual goals for school-wide effective behaviour support Evaluates ongoing efforts toward school-wide behaviour support Assists the design and revision procedures as needed Compares efforts toward school-wide effective behaviour support from year to year. 	Administered and results collated by PBL Coordinator.	Initially within 6-10 weeks of Tier 1 Universal Prevention Training.	2-3 hours.

Benchmarks of Quality (BoQ)	The Benchmarks of Quality is an assessment measure of the Tier 1 Universal Prevention School-wide PBL process.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identifies areas of strength and areas for improvement • Informs annual action planning • Assesses progress over time • Validates PBL team effort • Identifies exemplar schools • Assesses Tier 2 readiness 	School PBL team	Annually, around the same time	30-45 minutes
