## **TEEEC paragraphs**

We use a TEEEC scaffold for writing paragraphs to enhance our writing, and make it sound more sophisticated. It is important to give all the right information in a paragraph, in the correct order. Follow this scaffold for a successful paragraph:

Letter	Туре	Description
т	Topic Sentence	Your first sentence introduces the <b>TOPIC</b> you will be writing about in a paragraph.
E	Expand	The second sentence <b>EXPANDS</b> upon the topic, giving more information.
E	Example	This sentence provides an <b>EXAMPLE</b> of the topic you are writing about in this paragraph.
E	Explain	This sentence <b>EXPLAINS</b> what you are writing about. When you explain something you may use terms such as: this may result in; as a consequence; therefore;
С	Connect	This last sentence <b>CONNECTS</b> back to the topic introduced in the first sentence.

Have a go at writing a TEEEC paragraph as a class or by yourself. Remember not to leave any sentence out. Highlight them at the end in the correlating colours to make sure you have them all.

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
